APPLICATIONS

1. The content uploaded to any application shall not contain any of the following types of content and Fire Log Pty Ltd ACN 624 925 239 (**Fire Log**) reserves the right to delete any content that contains:

- Vulgar language
- Personal attacks of any kind
- Comments or content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, colour, age, religion, gender, marital status, genetics, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or intellectual disability or sexual orientation.
- Spam or links to other sites
- Off topic comments
- Advocate illegal activity
- Promotional material for particular services, products or political organisations
- Copyright or trademark infringements
- Personally identifiable medical information
- Information that may compromise the safety, security or proceedings of public systems or any criminal or civil investigation

2. You may not and may not allow any third party to:
